#### **Kings Canyon Day Tour**

In the early morning, travel to the Watarrka National Park at the western end of the George Gill Range to behold impressive Kings Canyon. Climb the escarpment to take in the magnificent views of the Red Centre then embark on the Rim Walk through the beehive-like sandstone domes that are the haven of more than 600 species of plants. Kings Canyon is considered botanically the richest region in central Australia. As an alternative to the Rim Walk, undertake the Kings Creek Walk and marvel at the canyon walls rising more than 300 meters from the valley floor, or explore Kathleen Springs. Return to Ayers Rock Resort in the late afternoon.
